Rules & Regulations for State Level Tournaments

Students as per following table are eligible to participate in Inter School Tournament.

S.No	Age Category	D.O.B Born on or after	Class limit in r/o age category
1	U-11 yrs	01.01.2006	
2	U-14 yrs	01.01.2003	Class 6 th to 8 th
3	U-17 yrs	01.01.2000	Upto 10 th class. 9 th /10 th student can participate in U 14yrs.
4	U-19 yrs	01.01.1998	Upto 12 th class. 11 th /12 th student can participate in U 17yrs

Note: As per SGFI decision, No Student studying upto 5th Class is Permitted to take part in the above said Tournament except for Roller Skating U 11 yrs age category.

Under no circumstances Jump over of age is to be permitted in r/o Body Contact Games i.e Football, Hockey, Judo, Taekwondo, Kho-Kho, Boxing, Fencing, Wrestling, Kabaddi, Handball, Circle Kabaddi, Netball, Basketball, Weightlifting and Gatka-- keeping in view the safety and apprehensive chances of Injuries to the players. **No Merit Certificate will be issued in case of Disobeying of this clause.**

2) In a calendar year, a player can participate in two team games ,one Individual game and Athletics only through one age group in the current session subject to eligibility of class and age.

3) In the case of local migration for class 10th and 12th, a student can join the new school upto 31st May. Whereas XI class students migrating from other states should get admission before 31st July (Except for XI class students getting admission through Administration Centralized Process) for the current year.

4) If a student participating in Inter School competition is found having enrolled in any other institution, the school team will be scratched immediately. To stop such incidents, the admission of the players/students shall be made on the production of original school leaving certificate and character certificate. The involved officials shall also be liable for departmental action against him/her.

5) Unrecognized schools are not eligible to participate in the State/National School Games. **The recognized schools having deposited sports affiliation fees of Rs. 5000/- to the Education Department shall only be allowed to participate in State/National School Games 2016-17 along with Undertaking by the school Principal regarding sparing services of their Physical Education teachers and their school playfields/courts/infrastructure for the conduct of Inter School Tournament, supervising camp and accompanying the contingent in r/o National School Games.**

6) a) There will be no competition if there are less than **Four Teams** in r/o Team games/**Four Players** in r/o Individual Discipline from different schools.

b) **In individual events, positions will only be declared when the competitors from four different schools will complete their bouts/tie/event.**

7) **One player** from a school will be allowed to participate in each weight category in r/o Weight lifting, Wrestling, Judo, Boxing, Taekwondo.. However, in the discipline of Swimming and Athletics two players from a school will be allowed to participate in each event. The **Event and Weight category** must be mentioned in front of each participant in the entry proforma. Addition/Deletion of participant/team can be done one day before the date of draws of fixtures with the written permission of Principal.

8) For D.O.B., the admission withdrawal register and original certificates will be considered to settle an objection raised by opponent team. The under objection team will produce the relevant record within 2 hours to the O/o District Education Officer. The objections/malpractices raised by any team will be dealt as per The Handbook of Instructions for Inter School tournament published by Education Department

9) The school must submit entry forms alongwith latest individual photograph of the players and must produced school I-Cards at the time of competition duly signed by the Head of the institution.

10) The District Education Officer may change the date/venue of the tournament due to weather conditions, clashing of dates with NSG or any other administrative reason.

11) The convener of the games shall ensure the availability of **FIRST AID KIT/DRINKING WATER FACILITIES/MEDICAL FACILITIES/DISCIPLINE/PROPER MARKING OF THE GROUND** etc. at the match venue.

12) The officials put on duty for Officiating/Table Duty during the tournament are required to wear proper kit.

13) It is mandatory for the Principal of Govt./Private Aided/Recognized schools to spare the services of Physical Education teachers of their schools for the Inter School competitions/duties on the verbal/written orders from the District Education Officer, State Sports Organizer and Convener of the game.

14) Following games are recognized by Sports Department, UT., Chandigarh for gradation.

1. Aquatics, (Swimming event wise), 2. Athletics (event wise), 3. Archery (event wise), 4. Badminton, 5. Baseball, 6. Basketball, 7. Boxing Men (Weight category wise), 8. Cricket, 9. Canoeing, 10. Cycling (event wise), 11. Fencing, (event wise), 12. Football, 13. Golf, 14. Gymnastics, 15. Handball, 16. Hockey, 17. Judo (Weight category wise), 18. Kabaddi, 19 Kho Kho, 20 Rowing (event wise), 21. Shooting (event wise), 22. Softball, 23. Skating, 24 Table Tennis, 25. Taekwondo, 26. Tennis, 27. Volleyball, 28. Weight Lifting (Weight category wise), 29. Wrestling (Weight Category wise).

15) The officials put on duty in the Inter School tournament will be given an amount of Rs. 20/- per match in the team games and Rs. 50/- per day in the other individual event as officiating charges. The convener shall be responsible for providing officiating charges to the officials.

16) The DSE(S) shall have the right to change any of the rules and regulations for the benefit of the participants and promotion of sports without assigning any reason.

NOTE: i) The Principal, Heads of the Govt./Aided/Private recognized schools are required to conduct terminal/semester examinations between 10th September to 30th September, so that the activities listed in the calendar can take place accordingly.

ii) The Handbook of Instructions for Inter School tournament published by Education Department will be consulted for any clarification.

You are directed to send the Entries of your respective teams/players as per tentative schedule and rules regulations as mentioned above.
