This is in continuation to this office memo NO. DSE-UT-S4-11(118)18-II/3351 dated 26.10.2021 vide which it was requested to get the notices served upon the concerned teachers and confirmed the delivery of Dasti Notices and to submit an affidavit to this effect in this office.

This office has received a copy of orders from Assistant Registrar Supreme Court of India dated 18.11.2021 (copy enclosed) and the extract of the same is as under:-

On the oral request made by the learned Solicitor General, coupled with the fact that number of respondents is high and that in that main matter service is already complete, which, could otherwise proceed for hearing in terms of the previous order, we deem it appropriate to direct the petitioners to serve the unserved respondents by dasti notice as well as additionally by paper publication within three weeks from today. Notice through paper publication can be issued in two local newspapers having wide circulation i.e. (The Tribune in English and Punjabi Tribune in Punjabi), mentioning the notified date of listing. Affidavit of service be filed within three weeks. If the concerned respondent(s) fail to appear on the date notified in the newspaper, the matter may proceed against such respondents ex-parte on the assumption that despite deemed service of notice, he/she had not chosen to appear in the proceedings. List the matters on 17th December, 2021.

Copies of 07 Notices to be published in said newspapers are also enclosed herewith. It is requested to get the same published in two local newspapers having wide circulation i.e. (The Tribune in English and Punjabi Tribune in Punjabi) by 06.12.2021 and furnish an affidavit in Supreme Court of India (through Sh. Shantanu Sagar, Govt. Counsel) well before the next date of hearing in the case in consultation with Law Officer and approval of the competent authority.

when you may appear before the court either in person or through Counsel and show cause to the Court as to why Special Leave and interim relief as prayed for be not granted and the resultant appeal be not allowed.

Take Further Notice that the prayer for interim relief after notice will also be listed before the Court on the aforesaid date.

You may file your affidavit in opposition to the petition as provided under Rule 14(1) of Order XXI, S.C.R.2013 within three weeks from the date of publication of notice or not later than 2 weeks before the date appointed for hearing, whichever be earlier, but shall do so only by setting out the grounds in opposition to the questions of law or grounds set out in the SLPs and may produce such pleadings and documents filed before the Court/Tribunal against whose order the SLP is filed and shall also set out the grounds for not granting interim order or for vacating interim order if already granted.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that if you fail to enter appearance as aforesaid, no further notice shall be given to you even after the grant of special leave for hearing of the resultant appeal and the matter above mentioned shall be disposed of in your absence.
