**Note:** Hindi or English must be one of the two languages to be studied in class XI and XII. Hindi and English can also be offered simultaneously. In Hindi and English, two courses have been provided for class XI and XII and the student may either opt Hindi Elective or Hindi Core and English Elective or English Core. However, the same language cannot be offered both at core and elective levels.

In addition to the above, the following combinations cannot be taken together:

- Business Studies and Business Administration
- Out of Computer Science/ IT related subjects, i.e. Computer Science and Information Technology, a candidate can opt only one subject
- Mathematics and Applied Mathematics

### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

**A candidate shall be eligible to get admission in Class XI:-**

1. If he/she has passed Matriculation Examination from Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi or any other Recognized Board or it's equivalent Examination recognized by C.B.S.E.
2. Students, who have been declared Pass by C.B.S.E as per their pass criteria, shall be eligible if he/she has been declared PASS' by the respective Board.
3. If he/she has not Passed higher examination Or equivalent from any other recognized Board/University.
4. Any Candidate placed under compartment in Class X shall be admitted provisionally to class XI till he/she passes the first chance compartment exam. His / Her admission shall be cancelled if he/she fails to pass the same.

### PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION:

1. Registration Form is to be filled online on the website of Education Department  
i.e. [www.chdeducation.gov.in](http://www.chdeducation.gov.in).  
Registration Form can also be filled up at [nielit.gov.in/chandigarh](http://nielit.gov.in/chandigarh).

Registration form shall be accepted online with Registration Fee amounting to Rs. 130/- only. payable through Net Banking/ Creditcard/Debitcard.

2. There is only one Registration Form for all the streams (Science, Commerce, Humanities Or Skill Courses). **Only one Registration Form is to be filled up by the candidate** seeking admission to Class XI in any Govt. School.
3. Candidates can fill up online form and in case they face any difficulty, they can seek guidance from helpline numbers. However, to facilitate the students in filling up of online forms, admission helpdesks would be set up in 25 schools. Students would visit these schools after taking time slot on Phone. The time slot will be given keeping in view the norms of social distancing. Staff on duty will guide the students for online filling of Admission Form and submission of scanned documents. These helpdesks would function from 09:00 am to 01:00 pm on all working days. The schools are as under:

4. In case of any problem in filling the form, the candidate can also take help of NIELIT Centre, Sector 30, Chandigarh from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on any working day, keeping in consideration the norms of social distance. Before visit, the students can seek appointment from NIELIT Centre on 0172-2650121 and visit the same as per time slot given to them.
  5. After filling in basic details by the candidate, a unique ID and password shall be generated, which the candidate shall have to keep safe for the future reference.
  6. Candidate shall have to login again using ID and Password generated for filling-in the Registration Form.
  7. In case a student has passed the Secondary School Examination from board other than CBSE, he/she is required to submit a scanned copy of Detailed Marks Certificate of Class X. Class X CBSE students (pass out of year 2021) are not required to attach the scanned copy of marks sheet.
  8. Candidates who have passed
    - i. Compartment Exam
    - ii. X Class exam in any year except 2021 are required to submit a scanned copy of their marks sheet with the Registration Form.
  9. Further, the candidates who belong to any reserved category would also have to submit a scanned copy of the relevant document/certificate claiming admission against the reserved seat. (Sports/ SC/ Physically Challenged/ Defence or Paramilitary/ Freedom Fighters' Children or Grandchildren/ Kashmiri Migrant). The benefit of reservation would be given only if the candidate uploads a scanned copy of the relevant certificate.
  10. After submission of the Registration Fee of Rs 130/-, the candidate is required to take a print out of the submitted form.



## Procedure for Admission...

11. The print out of the submitted Registration Form is to be retained by the candidate for its submission at the time of admission in the school, where the candidate shall be allotted a seat.
  12. Any claim of the candidate pertaining to the marks/ caste/ category shall not be entertained in the absence of uploading scanned copies of the relevant documents as mentioned at Points 7, 8 and 9 above.
  13. Particulars/ details filled online by the candidate as on the closing date/time shall be considered final and preparation of merit and allotment of seat shall be finalized on the basis of these details.
2. (i) If two or more candidates are having same total, than a candidate getting higher marks as mentioned under "1st Tie" will rank higher in order of merit.  
(ii) If two or more candidates are having same marks as mentioned under "1st Tie" then the candidates having higher marks as mentioned under "Subsequent Tie" will rank higher in order of merit.  
(iii) If two or more candidates are having same marks, under 1st Tie and subsequent Tie, the candidates having higher age shall rank higher in order of merit.

### Preparation of Merit:

1. Common merit will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in class X in the following 5 subjects:

**English, Mathematics, Social Sciences, General Science and Language II.**

In case the candidate had opted for more than one language (in addition to English) in class X examination, the language in which the candidate has secured higher marks will be considered (in lieu of language-II). In case Language-II is not offered by School Board, marks obtained by the candidate in any other subject will be considered. In case of Open School Examination, marks in any 5 subjects on the basis of which the candidate has been declared successful will be considered.

3. Common Merit list (Before "Tie break") prepared as per above criteria and other particulars will be uploaded on the website (**Date to be announced after declaration of result by CBSE**)

Candidate may check his /her status in the merit, other particulars such as category, gender, preference of school and stream.

### ALLOTMENT OF SCHOOL/STREAM

1. Seats will be allotted on basis of
  - (a) Position in Common Merit list after deciding "Tie" points.
  - (b) Order of preference of school and stream given by the candidate.
  - (c) Availability of seats in a particular school.
2. A Candidate will be admitted in one school and in one stream only.
3. List indicating the allotment of school and stream will be uploaded on the website. Names of all those candidates who have been allotted seats in various school shall be included in this list.

### Deposit of Fee

1. The candidates will have to take a print out of the Admission Form after logging in with his ID and password. This form, duly signed by the candidate and the parents has to be submitted along with the already filled in Registration Form in the school where the candidate has been allotted a seat. The details regarding the **submission of the forms shall be notified later on.**
2. The detailed instructions to **deposit fee and verification of documents** in the school where the candidate has been allotted a seat shall be **notified later on** along with display of merit list as per the then guidelines of MHA owing to the current Covid-19 pandemic.

### General Instructions

1. Admission can be refused to any candidate on valid reasons.
2. Admission to all the students will be provisional till the verification of Marks Sheet and other relevant documents of the opening of school. Admission will be confirmed only on production of documents, including migration certificate (wherever applicable).
3. (a) All Foreign/Overseas students are required to produce student visa/Residential Permit. Applicants with other types of Visas will not be considered for admission.  
(b) Eligibility Certificate from the CBSE must be furnished by all foreign students without which application for admission of foreign students will not be considered. Director School Education, Chd. Administration is also authorised to issue Eligibility Certificate.
4. No Candidate shall be allowed to change his/her subjects of study after Second Counselling.
5. Physical Education as an elective or addl. subject or in lieu of lang-II will be offered only if a student fulfils the conditions laid in Senior School Curriculum 2021-22 of CBSE, New Delhi.

**Note: In case a candidate fails to deposit the fee by the scheduled date, the candidate shall be barred and his form shall not be considered further for admission.**

  - (vii) 10 Seats each have been specially created in Skill Courses for Muslim girls in GSSS-45 & GSSS-ManimajraTown
  - (viii) One additional Seat per section shall be filled by Chandigarh Administration as per the guideline issued by Secretary Education, Chandigarh Administration.
- (b) Seats remained vacant under any reserved category will be allotted to the candidate of general category at the time of allotment of seats.
- (c) Certificate of Scheduled Caste issued by the Competent Authority of concerned State/U.T. in favor of the candidate.

(d) Son/Daughter wholly dependent on ex-servicemen i.e defence/paramilitary personnel like CRPF, BSF etc.

(e) Son/Daughter wholly dependent on serving defence and paramilitary personnel like CRPF, BSF etc

(v) For Freedom Fighter's Children/ Grand Children Category, the following are eligible (Please attach relevant proof)

Son/Daughter/Grandson/Grand daughter of Freedom Fighters who are awardees of Tamara Patra and Pension.

**Note:** Gradation Certificate is a must to claim the benefit of reservation under Sports Category



## General Conduct Rules...

- (i) To ensure that each student may enjoy the full benefits of the facilities placed at his/her disposal, he/she has to abide by the conduct rules and regulations of the institution. These are solely designed to safeguard the welfare of students and are liable to change without notice. The students are advised to keep themselves informed about the day-to-day instructions given in the schools. A plea of ignorance of any rule cannot be accepted as an excuse for breaking it.
- (ii) Students are expected to be in decorum and to pay due respect to the faculty and subordinate officials. Every member of staff has authority to forbid disorderly behavior within the institution.
- (iii) Loud talking, loitering or congregating in the corridor, being source of disturbance and annoyance to others is not permitted.
- (iv) Late arrival and early departure at or from a school are recorded as absence from the school.
- (v) It is misdemeanor to interfere with any apparatus or enter any lab/room other than directed.
- (vi) No student has any authority over the employees of the institution.
- (vii) Tools and other machinery must be left in good order after use. If damaged, the fact must be immediately reported for necessary action.
- (viii) The students at the institute require attention and diligence. A student neglecting his studies and showing unsatisfactory progress will be given two warnings after which if he fails to improve will be liable for expulsion from the institution.
- (ix) Students shall observe all safety precautions. The institution is not responsible for accident of whatsoever nature in the school/workshop/playground/work place. The Institution shall not be responsible for any untoward incident while commuting between home to school, school to home and to any training place.
- (x) **Students are not allowed to use mobile phone in the school campus.** Action will be taken by the school authorities against the defaulters.
- (xi) Conduct inconsistent with general school rules or persistent neglect of work or failure to respond promptly to official notice may be punished with levy of fines and even expulsion from the school in the interest of general discipline by the Principal.
- (xii) Instructions/Guidelines relating to a specific vocational course given in the course of studies issued by CBSE or any other subsequent institutions/guidelines/rules and regulations circulated by the authorities concerned are to be strictly followed.
- (xiii) The students are required to come to the school in proper uniform as prescribed by the Education Department, Chd Admn.
- (xiv) Parents can meet the teachers on the last Saturday of every month. However school can decide any other convenient day.



(xv) Rules for Change of Subject(s):

- (a) No candidates shall be permitted to change his/her subject of study after passing Class XI.
- (b) The candidate shall not offer a subject in Class XII which he has not studied and passed in Class XI.
- (c) Head of the Institution may allow change in subject in Class XI but not later than 31st October of that academic session.
- (d) The change of subject(s) stream has been allowed by CBSE to the failures of Class XII. However this change shall be permissible only from Science to Commerce and Humanities streams and not vice versa.
- (e) Notwithstanding the above, the Chairman of CBSE has the power to allow a candidate to appear in any subject he thinks desirable under exceptional circumstances.
- (f) No student shall be eligible to take the examination unless he has completed 75% of attendance counted from the beginning of class XI/XII upto the 1st of the month preceding the month of annual examination.

### **MOST IMPORTANT**

Students have to attend the classes regularly to the extent of minimum 75% and no relaxation in time and attendance shall be permitted.

### **Nature of Examination**

1. In order to orient the student towards competitive exams, MCQ tests are held regularly at the school level. Class XI examination shall be conducted internally by the schools themselves while Class XII examination based on

the syllabus for class XII only shall be conducted by the CBSE according to the following schemes:

- (a) The Board shall conduct examination in all subjects except General Studies/ Personality Development and Soft Skills, Work Experience, Physical and Health Education, which will be assessed internally by the schools.
- (b) In the subject examined by the Board a student will be given one paper each carrying 100 marks for 3 hours. However, in subject requiring practical examination there will be a theory paper and a practical examination as required in the course of studies.
- (c) In Work Experience, General Studies/ Personality Development and Soft Skills and Physical and Health Education, schools are required to maintain cumulative record of continuous evaluation of students achievement and progress. The record is subject to scrutiny by the Board as and when it deems necessary.
- (d) A candidate from a recognized school, having physical deformity or otherwise unable to take part in Work Experience and Physical and Health Education, may be granted exemption by the Chairman of the Board on the recommendation of the Head of the Institution supported by medical certificate from the Medical Officer of a rank not below an Assistant Surgeon.
- (e) A candidate may offer an additional subject which can be either a language at elective level or another elective subject as prescribed in the scheme of studies, subject to the conditions laid down in the Pass Criteria.



## Scheme of Examination...

### Terminal Examination

1. The terminal examination will be held in the months of September and December besides Unit tests.
2. Annual Examination will be held in the month of March. In case of board exam, it shall depend upon CBSE directions.
3. A student taking skill course will also undergo on the job training. Instructions of the department are to be adhered to in this regard.
4. All types of State and Centre Scholarships are tenable in all Senior Secondary Schools. There is no tuition fee for male students belonging to Scheduled Castes/Tribes. However, Scholarships/Stipends of all the categories are liable to be withdrawn if a student remains irregular in attendance or is found guilty of misbehaviour or shows unsatisfactory progress in studies.

Library facilities are provided in all Senior Secondary Schools of Chandigarh for students to avail opportunities for self reading.

Schools offering Skill Subjects also provide educational and vocational guidance for the choice of subject and career.

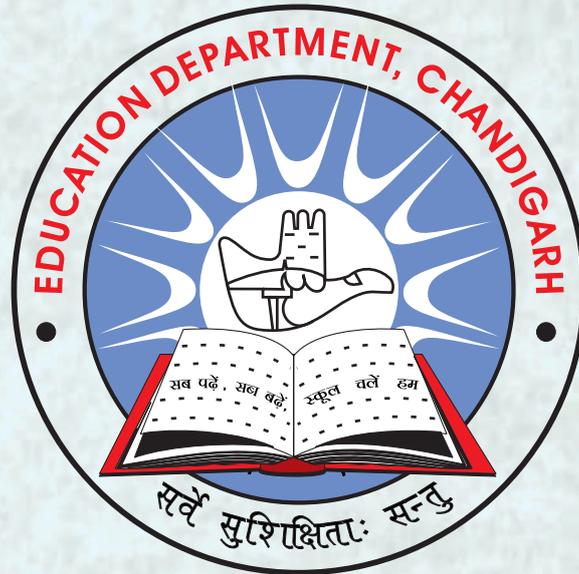
