





Note:

- (I) Hindi (Core) or English (Core) must be opted for and can also be studied simultaneously.
- (ii) The student who has studied Mathematics (Basic) in class X will have the option of opting for Applied Mathematics as an elective subject, though he/she will not be permitted to take Mathematics.
- (iii) Student who has studied Mathematics (Standard) in class X can opt for any of the two available Mathematics i.e. Mathematics or Applied Mathematics:
- (iv) The following combinations cannot be taken together:
 - Business Studies and Business Administration



- Out of Computer Science/IT-related subjects i.e. Informatics Practices, Computer Science and Information Technology, a candidate can opt for only one subject
- Mathematics and Applied Mathematics
- (iv) A candidate can also opt for an additional subject which may either be a language at elective level or any other elective subject.
- (v) If a student has taken a sixth subject and if he/she fails in any one of the five subjects, the same will be replaced by the sixth subject provided the candidate satisfies the scheme of studies i.e. after the replacement, either Hindi or English remains as one of the five subjects.
- (vi) Skill Electives can be offered along with any subject as per the scheme of studies (subject to the availability of the skill elective in the particular school).
- (vii) Physical Education as an elective or additional subject or in lieu of Lang-II will be offered only if a student fulfills the conditions laid in the Senior School Curriculum 2023-24 of CBSE, New Delhi.



Eligibility and Procedure for Admission



ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

A candidate shall be eligible for admission in class XI as per the following criteria:-

- 1. If he/she has **passed** class-X examination from the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, or any other recognized board or its equivalent exam recognized by the CBSE.
- 2. If he/she has **passed** higher examination or equivalent from any other recognized board/university.
- 3. Any candidate placed under **compartment** in class X shall be admitted provisionally to class XI till he/she passes the compartment exam in the first chance. His/her admission shall be cancelled if he/she fails to pass the same.
- 4. For admission in Science stream (Medical/Non-Medical), the student must have obtained at least 50% marks each in the subjects of Science and Maths.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- 1. Registration form is to be filled online at www.chdeducation.gov.in.
- 2. Non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 200/- shall be payable online.
- 3. There is only one registration form for all the streams (Science-Medical/Non-Medical, Commerce, Humanities or Skill Courses) and hence **only one registration form is to be filled up by the candidate** seeking admission to class XI in any government school.
- 4. Students can fill up online form from their respective govt. schools of UT, Chandigarh from where they have appeared for class X under the guidance of the available faculty from 9 am to 1 pm on all working days. Staff will guide the students in online filling and submission of the admission form.
- 5. In case of any problem in filling up the form, the candidate can also take help of NIELIT, Sector 30, Chandigarh, from 10 am to 5 pm on any working day. Before visit, the students may seek appointment from the NIELIT centre at the given number (0172-2650121) and visit the same as per the time slot given to them.
- 6. After a candidate fills in the basic details, a unique ID and password shall be generated, which the candidate shall have to keep safe for future reference.
- 7. Candidates shall have to login again using ID and password generated after filling in the registration form.
- 8. In case, a student has passed the secondary school examination from board other

Eligibility and Procedure for Admission



- than the CBSE, he/she is required to submit a scanned copy of the detailed marks certificate (DMC) of class X. CBSE students, who passed class X in the year 2023, need not attach the scanned copy of the DMC.
- 9. The candidates, who have passed (i) compartment exam (ii) class-X exam in any year except 2023, are required to submit a scanned copy of their DMC with the registration form.
- 10. The candidates, who belong to any reserved category, would also have to upload a scanned copy of the relevant document/certificate claiming admission against the reserved seat. (Sports/SC/Differently Abled or Physically Challenged/Defence/Paramilitary/Freedom Fighters' Children or Grandchildren/Kashmiri Migrant).
- 11. On filling up of the form, the candidate will have to pay Admission Fee and Funds. On successful fee payment, the candidate will submit the form.
- 12. The candidate must take a print-out of the submitted form. The print-out of the registration form is to be retained by the candidate for its final submission (offline) at the time of admission in the school, where the candidate shall be allotted a seat.
- 13. Any claim of a candidate pertaining to the marks/caste/category shall not be entertained if he/she has not uploaded scanned copies of the relevant documents as mentioned earlier (see points 8, 9 & 10 above).
- 14. Particulars/details filled online by candidates as on the closing date/time shall be considered final. The preparation of merit list and allotment of seat shall be finalized on the basis of these details.



COMMON MERIT LIST



PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST

1. A common merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by students in class X in the following five subjects:

English, Mathematics, Social Sciences, General Science and Language II.

2. In case, a candidate had opted for more than one language (in addition to English) in class-X examination, the language in which the candidate has secured higher marks, will be considered in lieu of Language-II. In case, Language-II is not offered by the school board, marks obtained by a candidate in any other subject will be considered. In case of open-school exam, marks in any five subjects, on the basis of which the candidate has been declared successful, shall be considered.

3. Tie Breakers

- (I) If two or more candidates have the same total, then a candidate getting higher marks as mentioned under the '1st Tie' will rank higher in order of merit.
- (ii) If two or more candidates have the same marks as mentioned under the '1st Tie', then the candidates having higher marks as mentioned under the 'Subsequent Tie' will rank higher in order of merit.
- (iii) If two or more candidates have the same marks, under the '1st Tie' and the 'Subsequent Tie', the candidate who is elder in age shall be placed above in the merit list.
- 4. A common merit list (before 'Tie Break') prepared as per above criteria and other particulars will be uploaded on the website www.chdeducation.gov.in as per the schedule given on Page No. 24.
 - Candidates may check their status in the common merit list and other particulars such as category, gender, preference of school and stream.
- 5. In case, there is any discrepancy/objection, candidate shall submit the same through email on a specified proforma. For this purpose, the candidate has to log in with his ID and password. He/she may also seek telephonic help from the helpline numbers as mentioned on Page No. 39.

Preparation of Merit



Allotment of School/Stream

- 1. Seats will be allotted on the basis of
 - (a) Position in respective merit list (Government school pass-outs and other schools categories) after deciding the 'Tie' points.
 - (b) Order of preference of school and stream given by the candidate.
 - (c) Availability of seats in a particular school.
- 2. A candidate will be admitted to one school and in one stream only.
- 3. The list indicating the allotment of school and stream will be uploaded on www.chdeducation.gov.in. Names of all those candidates, who have been allotted seats in various schools, shall be included in this list.

Fee Deposit

- 1. The candidate shall have to pay the following fee (online)
 - (a) Registration Fee (non-refundable): Rs. 200/-
 - (b) Admission Fee and Funds (detailed at pages 35-36):

- 2. Should the candidate not be allotted a seat or chooses not to take admission, the Admission Fee and Funds amount, without any deduction will be refunded to the same account where it is being paid from. No request for refund into any other account shall be entertained.
- 3. Once the admission is finalised any excess payment by a candidate in the Admission Fee and Funds account will be adjusted in subsequent dues payable.
- 4. Once the admission is secured and acknowledged by the candidate thereafter if the admitted person chooses not to proceed with attending classes (for any reason) the department will not refund the paid Admission Fee and Funds and the amount shall be forfeited.

Preparation of Merit



General Instructions

- 1. Admission can be denied to any candidate on any valid reasons.
- 2. Admission will be provisional till the verification of marks sheet and other relevant documents by the school allocated to him/her.
- 3. Admission will be confirmed only on production of documents, including migration certificate (wherever applicable).
- 4. All foreign/overseas students are required to produce student visa/ residential permit. Applicants with other types of visas will not be considered for admission.
- 5. Eligibility certificate from the CBSE must be furnished by all foreign students without which the application for admission of foreign students will not be considered. Director School Education, Chandigarh Administration, is also authorised to issue eligibility certificate.



Note: The payment of Admission Fee and Funds is mandatory, without which, the admission form will remain incomplete and the candidate will not be considered for admission.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

The reservation shall apply as under:

- 85% of the total seats in Government Senior Secondary Schools of UT, Chandigarh, would be reserved for class-X pass-outs of government schools of Chandigarh. The seats would be filled on the basis of merit in the board exams, students' school preference and availability of seats in schools.
- 15% of the total seats in Government Senior Secondary Schools of UT, Chandigarh, shall be for the pass-outs of private schools of UT, Chandigarh, and students from other states and other boards to be filled on the basis of percentage of marks obtained by the students in the board exams, students' school preference and availability of seats in schools.

General Conduct Rules



- 1. Students must abide by the rules and regulations of the school. These are solely designed to safeguard the welfare of the students and may be changed without any prior notice. The students are advised to keep themselves informed about the day-to-day instructions given in the schools. A plea of ignorance of any rule cannot be accepted as an excuse for breaking it.
- 2. Students are expected to maintain decorum and to pay due respect to the faculty and other school officials. Every member of the staff has authority to forbid disorderly behaviour in the school.
- 3. Disorderly behaviour, loitering or congregating in the corridors, being source of disturbance and annoyance to others, is not permitted.
- 4. Late arrival at and early departure from the school will be recorded as absence from the school.
- 5. It is misdemeanour to interfere with any apparatus or enter any lab/room other than directed.
- 6. Tools and other machinery must be left in good order after use. If damaged, the fact must be immediately reported.
- 7. The students at the school require attention and diligence. A student neglecting his/her studies and showing unsatisfactory progress will be given two warnings, after which, if he/she fails to improve, is liable for expulsion from school.
- 8. Students shall observe all safety precautions. The school shall not be responsible for accident of whatsoever nature in the school/workshop/playground/work place. The school shall not be responsible for any untoward incident while commuting between home to school and school to home and to any place of training.
- 9. Students are not allowed to use mobiles on the school campus. Action will be taken against the defaulters.
- 10. Conduct inconsistent with general school rules or persistent neglect of work or failure to respond promptly to official notice may be punished with levy of fines and even expulsion from the school in the interest of general discipline by the principal.

General Conduct Rules



- 11. Instructions/guidelines relating to a specific skill course given in the course of study issued by the CBSE or any other subsequent instructions/guidelines/rules and regulations circulated by the authorities concerned are to be strictly followed.
- 12. The students are required to come to school in proper uniform as prescribed by the Education Department, Chandigarh Administration.
- 13. Parents can meet the teachers on the last Saturday of every month. However, school can decide any other convenient day.
- 14. Rules for change of subject(s):
 - a. No candidate shall be permitted to change his/her subjects of study after passing class XI.
 - b. Head of the school may allow change in subject in class XI but not later than 31st October of the academic session.
 - c. The change of subject (s)/stream has been allowed by the CBSE to the failures of class XII. However, this change shall be permissible only from Science to Commerce or Humanities streams and not vice versa.
- 15. No student shall be eligible to take the examination unless he has completed 75% of attendance counted from the beginning of class XI/XII up to the 1st of the month preceding the month of annual examination.



Scheme of Examination



Nature of Examination

In order to orient the students towards competitive examination, MCQ tests are held regularly at the school level. Class-XI examination shall be conducted internally by the schools themselves while class-XII examination based on the syllabus for class XII only shall be conducted by the CBSE according to the following scheme:

- a. The board shall conduct examination in all subjects except General Studies/Personality Development and Soft Skills, Work Experience, Physical and Health Education, which will be assessed internally by the school.
- b. In the subject examined by the board, a student will be given one paper each carrying 100 marks for 3 hours. However, in subject requiring practical examination, there will be a theory paper and a practical examination as required in the course of studies.
- c. In Work Experience, General Studies/Personality Development and Soft Skills and Physical and Health Education, schools are required to maintain cumulative record of continuous evaluation of students' achievements and progress. The record is subject to scrutiny by the Board as and when it deems necessary.
- d. A candidate from a recognized school, having physical deformity or otherwise unable to take part in Work Experience and Physical and Health Education, may be granted exemption by the chairman of the board, on the recommendation of the head of the school, supported by medical certificate from the medical officer of the rank not below an Assistant Surgeon.
- e. A candidate may opt for an additional subject which can be either a language at elective level or another elective subject as prescribed in the scheme of studies, subject to the conditions laid down in the **pass criteria**.

Scheme of Examination



Terminal Examination:

- 1. The terminal examination will be held in the month of September besides two unit tests which would be held between the months of November and January.
- 2. The annual examination shall be held in the month of March. In case of board examination, it shall depend on the directions of the CBSE.
- 3. A student taking skill course will also undergo on-the-job training. Instructions of the department are to be adhered to in this regard.
- 4. All types of state and centre scholarships are acceptable in all senior secondary schools. However, scholarships/stipends of all the categories are liable to be withdrawn if a student remains irregular in attendance or is found guilty of misbehaviour or shows unsatisfactory progress in studies.

It offers multifarious educational resources in multi-platform mode viz. digital/online, TV, radio, community radio, podcast, etc. The multi-modal components of PM e-Vidya initiative are:

DIKSHA as 'One Nation-One Digital Platform', hosts a plenty of multi-modal educational contents free for the use of learners, teachers and any stakeholders working in the field of education.

12 TV channels: One of the major components of PM e-Vidya initiative is 'One Class-One Channel' where 12 DTH television channels are dedicated to the transmission of educational contents for Classes 1 to 12 based on the NCERT curriculum.

It is a matter of immense pride for the Education Department, Chandigarh, that 28 teachers of the department were selected by the NCERT to create content for the PM e-Vidya program. They have contributed around 7000 videos for classes 1-12. These videos are being telecast regularly on the PM e-Vidya channels. This content is also available on DIKSHA platform.




