- Department of Education, UT Chandigarh has been actively engaged in developing a
 culture of participation in competitive sports as a means of creating a fit, healthy and
 vibrant society. Sport is woven in the fabric of every community in the state. The city
 has performed well in sports at the national and international level in the past and has
 huge opportunities to develop more athletes in various other sports.
- 2. Chandigarh is amongst top cities across the country and has a number of sports infrastructural assets across à wide spectrum of sports. Having an existing sports infrastructure of repute is an advantage in itself.
- 3. UT Chandigarh has a good network of 111 Govt. Schools, 7 Govt. Aided schools, 83 recognized private schools, 7 Central Govt. schools run by Kendriya Vidyalaya /Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti/ Air Force. Barring a few, all schools are of composite nature covering grades I to X/XII.All the inhabited sectors in UT Chandigarh are covered by school education as per habitation norms. - 4. - (d) Oversee and manage the coaching of children and sports professionals.
- 7.2 Sports Associations: Sports Associations will guide and assist for a sport and
 - (a) Provide support training with scientific &sports equipment and scientific and qualified personnel (trainers&coaches) and helping schools to

- conducting discipline specific competitions at various levels and monitoring the performances.
- (b) Assist the Department in providing technical support for the sport including promotion of specific sport discipline.
- (c) Monitor and enhance Performance with a scientific evaluation system
- (d) Work with the Department:
 - (i) To monitor the progress of the specific sport discipline and prepare the roadmap in consultation with the Department.
 - (ii) Applications of scientific methodology to detect, select, identify, nurture, develop and train to produce champion athletes
- (e) Deployment/ Positioning of
 - (i) Qualified Professional Coach for the allotted sports at the Schools.
 - (ii) requisite number of Qualified technical manpower, Sports equipment and gadgets
- 8. Eligibility Criteria: The Sports Associations of UT Chandigarh recognized by the Sports Department, UT Chandigarh and should been recognised with the National Sports Body recognised by the Ministry of Sports Government of India and the collaborative arrangements will be initially for 02 years extendable by 01 year an mutual agreeable terms.

9. Miscellaneous Provisions:
