

- (ii) Hindi (Core) and English (Core) can also be studied simultaneously.
- (iii) The first 5 subjects in the chronological order of filling the subjects in the online registration system/ Mark Sheet are considered as Main subjects.
- (iv) A candidate can also opt for an additional elective which may either be a language at elective level or, any other elective subject.
- (v) The student who has studied Mathematics (Basic) in class X will have the option of opting for only Applied Mathematics as an elective subject.
- (vi) The following combinations cannot be taken together:
 - Business Studies and Business Administration





SCHEME OF STUDIES AT SENIOR SECONDARY LEVEL

- Out of Computer Science/IT-related subjects i.e. Informatics Practices, Computer Science and Information Technology, a candidate can opt for only one subject
- Mathematics or Applied Mathematics
- (vii) If a student has taken a sixth subject and if he/she fails in any one of the five subjects, the same will be replaced by the sixth subject provided the candidate satisfies the scheme of studies i.e. after the replacement, either Hindi or English remains as one of the five subjects.
- (viii) Skill Electives can be offered along with any subject as per the scheme of studies (subject to the availability of the skill elective in the particular school).

ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

A candidate shall be eligible for admission in class XI as per the following criteria:-

- 1. If he/she has **passed** class-X examination from the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi or Class-X examination or equivalent from any other recognized board/university.
- 2. Any candidate placed under **compartment** in class X shall be admitted provisionally in class XI and is required to pass the compartment exam in first chance. His/her admission shall be cancelled if he/she fails to pass the same in the first chance.
- 3. For admission in Science stream (Medical/Non-Medical), the student must have obtained at least **50% marks** each in the subjects of **Science and Maths** in Class X board exam.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- 1. Registration form is to be filled online at <u>www.chdeducation.gov.in.</u>
- 2. Non-refundable registration fee of **Rs. 250/-** shall be payable online at the time of filling the form.
- 3. There are **separate registration forms** for UT Chandigarh Govt. Schools pass-out students and private schools/other state/boards pass-out students. The registration form is to be filled up by the candidate accordingly in streams of their choice.
- 4. Students can fill up online form from any govt. schools of UT, Chandigarh under the guidance of the available faculty from 9 am to 12 noon on all working days in the period of vacations.
- 5. In case of any problem in filling up the form, the candidate can also take help of NIELIT, Sector 30, Chandigarh, from 10 am to 5 pm on any working day or contact on the given number 0172-2650121.
- 6. After a candidate fills in the basic details, a unique ID and password shall be generated, which the candidate shall have to keep safe for future reference.
- 7. Candidates shall have to login again using ID and password generated after filling in the registration form.
- 8. In case, a student has passed the secondary school examination from board other than the CBSE, he/she is required to submit a scanned copy of the detailed marks certificate (DMC) of class X. CBSE students, who have passed class X in the year 2025, need not attach the scanned copy of the DMC.





ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- 9. The candidates, who have passed (i) compartment exam (ii) class-X exam in any year except 2025, are required to submit a scanned copy of their DMC with the registration form.
- 10. The candidates, who belong to any reserved category, would also have to upload a scanned copy of the relevant document/certificate claiming admission against the reserved seat. (Sports/SC/Differently abled or Physically Challenged/Defence/ Paramilitary/Freedom Fighters' children or grandchildren/Kashmiri Migrant).
- 11. On filling up of the form and successful Registration fee payment, the candidate will submit the form.
- 12. The candidate must take a print-out of the submitted form. The print-out of the registration form is to be retained by the candidate for its final submission (offline) at the time of admission in the school, where the candidate shall be allotted a seat.
- 13. The student must check his/her details in the common merit list and report online in case of any grievance (according to the details mentioned on page No. 37). No request of any change shall be entertained afterwards.
- 14. The admission fee must be paid online after the allotment of seat. THE ADMISSION WILL BE CONFIRMED ONLY AFTER THE PAYMENT OF ADMISSION FEE. ADMISSION FEE ONCE PAID WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.
- 15. Any claim of a candidate pertaining to the marks/caste/category shall not be entertained if he/she has not uploaded scanned copies of the relevant documents as mentioned earlier (see points 8, 9 & 10 above).
- 16. Particulars/details filled online by candidates as on the closing date/time shall be considered final. The preparation of merit list and allotment of seat shall be finalized on the basis of these details.

PREPARATION OF MERIT

Allotment of School/Stream

- 1. Seats will be allotted on the basis of
 - (a) Position in respective merit list after deciding the 'Tie' points.
 - (b) Order of preference of school and stream given by the candidate.
 - (c) Availability of seats in a particular school.
- 2. A candidate will be admitted to one school and in one stream only.
- 3. The list indicating the allotment of school and stream will be uploaded on <u>www.chdeducation.gov.in.</u> Names of all those candidates, who have been allotted seats in various schools, shall be included in this list.

Fee Payable

- 1. The candidate shall have to pay the following fee (online)
 - (a) Registration Fee (non-refundable): Rs. 250/-
 - (b) Admission Fee and Funds (detailed at pages 35-36):
 - Boys (General Category) Girls (General Category) SC (Boys and Girls)

Rs. 1,178/-Rs. 878/-Rs. 520/-

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PREPARATION OF MERIT

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General Instructions

- 1. Admission can be denied to any candidate on any valid reasons.
- 2. Admission will be provisional till the verification of mark sheet and other relevant documents by the school allocated to him/her.
- 3. Admission will be confirmed only on production of documents, including migration certificate (wherever applicable) and the payment of Admission fee.
- 4. All foreign/overseas students are required to produce student visa/ residential permit. Applicants with other types of visas will not be considered for admission.
- 5. Eligibility certificate from the CBSE must be furnished by all foreign students without which the application for admission of foreign students will not be considered. Director School Education, Chandigarh Administration, is also authorised to issue eligibility certificate.

Note: The payment of Admission Fee and Funds is mandatory for admission.

ALLOCATION OF SEATS

The allocation of seats shall be done as under:

- Approximately 85% of the total seats in Government Senior Secondary Schools of UT, Chandigarh, would be allocated to class X pass-outs of government schools of Chandigarh. The seats would be filled on the basis of merit in the board exams, students' school preference and availability of seats in schools.
- Approximately 15% of the total seats in Government Senior Secondary Schools of UT, Chandigarh, shall be for the pass-outs of private schools of UT, Chandigarh, and students from other states and other boards. They are to be filled on the basis of percentage of marks obtained by them in the board exams, students' school preference and availability of seats in schools.

Allocation for both categories (Government school pass-outs of UT Chandigarh and passouts from other schools and boards) shall be as under:

i Scheduled Caste	15%
ii Sports Category	2%
iii Children with special needs/Persons with disabilities	5%
iv Children of Defence/Paramilitary Personnel	5%
v Freedom Fighters' Children/Grand Children	2%
vi Kashmiri Migrants	1 (Additional seat per section)
vii Muslim Girls (Additional seats)	10 seats each in Fashion Studies, Textile Design & Design in GSSS-45 & GSSS-MMT





MERIT LIST

- (I) For both the categories, i.e. government school pass-outs and pass-outs from other schools and boards, separate merit lists shall be prepared.
- (ii) Any seat remaining unfilled in any of the reserved categories of government school pass-outs category will be shifted to the general seats of the government school pass-outs category.
- (iii) Any seat, remaining unfilled out of the total seats allocated for pass-outs of government schools of Chandigarh, will be made available to the general category pass-outs of private schools of Chandigarh and other states and other boards.

ADDITIONAL SPORTS SEATS

GENERAL CONDUCT RULES

- 1. Students must abide by the rules and regulations of the school. These are solely designed to safeguard the welfare of the students and may be changed without any prior notice. The students are advised to keep themselves informed about the day-to-day instructions given in the schools. A plea of ignorance of any rule cannot be accepted as an excuse for breaking it.
- 2. Students are expected to maintain decorum and to pay due respect to the faculty and other school officials. Every member of the staff has authority to forbid disorderly behaviour in the school.
- 3. Disorderly behaviour, loitering or congregating in the corridors, being source of disturbance and annoyance to others, is not permitted.
- 4. Late arrival at and early departure from the school will be recorded as absence from the school.
- 5. It is misdemeanour to interfere with any apparatus or enter any lab/room other than directed.
- 6. Tools and other machinery must be left in good order after use. If damaged, the fact must be immediately reported.
- 7. A student neglecting his/her studies and showing unsatisfactory progress will be given two warnings, after which, if he/she fails to improve, is liable for expulsion from school.
- 8. Students shall observe all safety precautions. The school shall not be responsible for accident of whatsoever nature in the school/workshop/playground/work place. The school shall not be responsible for any untoward incident while commuting between home to school and school to home and to any place of training.
- 9. Students are not allowed to use mobiles on the school campus. Action will be taken against the defaulters.
- 10. Conduct inconsistent with general school rules or persistent neglect of work or failure to respond promptly to official notice may be punished with levy of fines and even expulsion from the school in the interest of general discipline by the Principal.
- 11. Instructions/guidelines relating to a specific skill course given in the course of study issued by the CBSE or any other subsequent

instructions/guidelines/rules and regulations circulated by the authorities concerned are to be strictly followed.

- 12. The students are required to come to school in proper uniform as prescribed by the Department of School Education, Chandigarh.
- 13. Parents can meet the teachers on the last Saturday of every month. However, school can decide any other convenient day.
- 14. General Rules:
 - a. No candidate shall be permitted to change his/her subjects of study after passing class XI.
 - b. Head of the school may allow change in subject in class XI but not later than 31st October of the academic session.
 - c. The change of subject (s)/stream has been allowed by the CBSE to the failures of class XII. However, this change shall be permissible only from Science to Commerce or Humanities streams and not vice versa.
 - d. No candidate shall be permitted intra-city migration/change/transfer of school in class XII.
 - e Department reserves the right to allow change of allotted school in exceptional circumstances involving health etc. condition of the student.
- 15. No student shall be eligible to take the examination unless he has completed 75% of attendance counted from the beginning of class XI/XII up to the 1st of the month preceding the month of annual examination.







SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Nature of Examination

In order to orient the students towards competitive examination, MCQ tests are held regularly at the school level. Class-XI examination shall be conducted internally by the schools themselves while class-XII examination based on the syllabus for class XII only shall be conducted by the CBSE according to the following scheme:

- a. The board shall conduct examination in all subjects except General Studies/Personality Development and Soft Skills, Work Experience, Physical and Health Education, which will be assessed internally by the school.
- b. In the subjects examined by the board, a student will be given one paper each carrying 100 marks for 3 hours. However, in subjects requiring practical examination, there will be a theory paper and a practical examination as required in the course of studies.
- c. In Work Experience, General Studies/Personality Development and Soft Skills and Physical and Health Education, schools are required to maintain cumulative record of continuous evaluation of students' achievements and progress. The record is subject to scrutiny by the Board as and when it deems necessary.
- d. A candidate from a recognized school, having physical deformity or otherwise unable to take part in Work Experience and Physical and Health Education, may be granted exemption by the chairman of the board, on the recommendation of the head of the school, supported by medical certificate from the medical officer of the rank not below an Assistant Surgeon.
- e. A candidate may opt for an additional subject which can be either a language at elective level or another elective subject as prescribed in the scheme of studies, subject to the conditions laid down in the **pass criteria**.







SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Terminal Examination:

- 1. The terminal examination will be held in the month of September besides two unit tests which would be held between the months of November and January.
- 2. The annual examination shall be held in the months of February-March. In case of board examination, it shall depend on the directions of the CBSE.
- 3. A student taking skill course will also undergo on-the-job training. Instructions of the department are to be adhered to in this regard.
- 4. All types of state and centre scholarships are acceptable in all senior secondary schools. However, scholarships/stipends of all the categories are liable to be withdrawn if a student remains irregular in attendance or is found guilty of misbehaviour or shows unsatisfactory progress in studies.
